


That experience has shown me the passion I have for missions and my desire to serve internationally and now I have the opportunity to go to the country of South Africa for two months and be a part of a awesome summer internship program with Impact Africa.

Impact Africa is located in Johannesburg, South Africa and their goal is to bring hope to the hopeless. Impact Africa has two preschools, a baby rescue center, a missions program, as well as the Impact Me missionary experience program. Someone set the base on fire last year, and we are going to help them with continued efforts to make the base be "home" to many young Haitian, Dominican, and American missionaries.*

During the week of June 22nd through 29th, we have the chance to serve with our friends ministry, SparrowMissions ([www.sparrowmissions.com](http://www.sparrowmissions.com)), in Honduras. This 7-day mission trip will be spent interacting with and spreading the gospel to the Honduran people, while also learning more about the people there and their culture. We will be privileged to reach out to individuals, children and families in poor areas, a local orphanage, nursing home, and schools.
